Parent Worship Questions Worship ideas for Fundamental 1 The Word of God

For Parents (From God loves me 28 Ways for kids Book by Charles Mills & Linda Koh: GC CHM Department, pg 13)

- The word Bible comes from the Greek word biblia, meaning "books."
- The Bible was written by different people over a period of sixteen hundred years.
- The Bible has sixty-six books and is divided into two parts the Old Testament and the New Testament.
- The Old Testament is made up of thirty-nine books and is written in the Hebrew language. They include the law, history, wisdom and poetry, Major Prophets and Minor Prophets.
- The New Testament contains twenty-seven books and is written in the Greek language. It is made up of the Gospels, church history, letters by the apostle Paul, other general letters and prophecy.

Start with the end in mind

• Parents and children need to remember that because God created us and this world He knows best how we operate so we need to spend time every day reading His instruction manual called the Bible (a.k.a. Scripture, the Word, Letter from God). Daily reading the Word and obeying what we read there will help us to navigate life more successfully (2 Timothy 3:16-17 [ICB] All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching and for showing people what is wrong in their lives. It is useful for correcting faults and teaching how to live right. Using the Scriptures, the person who serves God will be ready and will have everything he needs to do every good work; Joshua 1:8 [NLT] Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.)

- Families need to remember that when God gives us instructions in the Bible to keep away from certain things, people or situations, we will experience longer lasting happiness if we choose to obey those instructions. (Luke 11:28 [GNT] But Jesus answered, "Rather, how happy are those who hear the word of God and obey it!; Psalm 119:1-2 [NLT] Joyful are people of integrity, who follow the instructions of the Lord. Joyful are those who obey his laws and search for him with all their hearts.)
- Parents need to model for children the habit of daily reading the Bible as well as practical ways to apply what they read in the Bible. This should be especially evident through the way parents treat their disobedient children. (Deuteronomy 11:18-19 [NLT] "So commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these words of mine. Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. Teach them to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up.)
- Parents will be investing wisely if they spend time and resources teaching their children creative ways to enjoy reading the Bible and applying it to their everyday lives. (2 Timothy 3:14-15 [ERV] But you should continue following the teaching you learned. You know it is true, because you know you can trust those who taught you. You have known the Holy Scriptures since you were a child. These Scriptures are able to make you wise. And that wisdom leads to salvation through faith in Christ Jesus; Proverbs 22:6-7 [CEV] Teach your children right from wrong, and when they are grown they will still do right.)


Using the Tuis Video - Worship Objectives

- Taking time to read instructions/manuals for building something, will save you a lot of time and heartache physically and spiritually. (Sefa refused to use the instruction manual to build the table so it was a flimsy table which overturned and ruined Salome's birthday cake. Likewise, if we take time to regularly study God's Word (His instruction manual and letter to us, as our Creator), it will help us to avoid much pain and heartbreak in life.)
- When loving parents turn down a request from their children, it is often to protect them from harm, so children need to learn to obey their parents' instructions. (Marica turned down Salome's request to use the hair straightener because Marica knew that it wasn't working, so it would not make Salome look beautiful for her birthday party. When Salome disobeyed this instruction, her hair was completely spoiled.)



Colouring in can be a nice calming activity to do while having a discussion.






What happened to the table that Sefa and

How Sefa put right his mistake of building a coffee table which collapsed so easily because he didn't follow the instructions provided? (He offered, with Jonathan, to whip up a cake to help everyone forget about Salome's terrifying clown makeup)

We as a family can learn something from this video clip?



Now ask God in prayer to forgive you for not spending much time reading His instructions in the Bible. Then ask for His power to obey the Holy Spirit's invitation each day to spend time with Him by reading the Bible.

- (A) (Yes) What clues in the video suggest this? (Emma and Emily stated that they had a similar table but that it was taller and didn't have a burned leg. This implied that they followed instructions when building it, unlike Sefa's strange looking table because he refused to use the instructions.)
- (B) (No) Give a reason, based on the video. (Jonathan kept trying to get his father to read and follow the instructions many times. He also reminded his father about what happened to Kosta a couple of weeks earlier when his dad didn't follow instructions for building the trampoline.)
- (C) (Yes) Explain your answer using examples from the video.


(*Children*: 1) Disobeying parents' instructions results in unhappiness. When Salome disobeyed Marica's instruction about the hair straightener, Salome spoiled her hair and looked terrible at her own birthday party. 2) When our willful disobedience leads to something being damaged, we need to apologize and then offer to fix the damage, if possible. Salome did this when she offered to save up to buy a new Strawmaker to replace Marica's one that Salome thought she had broken.

Parents: 1) When we realise we've done the wrong thing in front of our children, we need to admit our wrong verbally and then correct our mistakes. Sefa showed this by admitting that it was wrong to ignore the instructions when building the table. He then offered to bake a new cake and also agreed to Jonathan's suggestion to use the recipe for baking the cake. 2) Be quick to forgive our children's mistakes. When Salome apologized and tried to offer to replace the broken Strawmaker, Marica showed she'd forgiven her by gently joking with Salome about her makeup, giving her a hug and explaining that the Strawmaker was already broken. Marica then clarified that she was only protecting Salome from harm and embarrassment.

Both: For everyone's safety, we should use instruction manuals when building something we have never built before. When Sefa and Jonathan didn't use the instruction manual to build the table, the risk of accidents increased for everyone in their household.)





I will quickly admit it usually takes a minister to find one of them, and there will be loud lamentations when it is found. A little lady says she brews a cup of tea so she can concentrate better. See how well you can compete. Relax now. There really are sixteen names of books in this story.

There are 30 books of the Bible in this paragraph. Can you find them? This is a most remarkable puzzle. It was found by a gentleman in an airplane seat pocket, on a flight from Los Angeles to Honolulu, keeping him occupied for hours. He enjoyed it so much, he passed it on to some friends. One friend from Illinois worked on this while fishing from his john boat. Another friend studied it while playing his banjo. Elaine Taylor, a columnist friend, was so intrigued by it she mentioned it in her weekly newspaper column. Another friend judges the job of solving this puzzle so involving, she brews a cup of tea to help her nerves. There will be some names that are really easy to spot. That's a fact. Some people, however, will soon find themselves in a jam, especially since the book names are not necessarily capitalized.

Truthfully, from answers we get, we are forced to admit it usually takes a minister or a scholar to see some of them at the worst. Research has shown that something in our genes is responsible for the difficulty we have in seeing the books in this paragraph. During a recent fund raising event, which featured this puzzle, the Alpha Delta Phi lemonade booth set a new record. The local paper, The Chronicle, surveyed over 200 patrons who reported that this puzzle was one of the most difficult they had ever seen. As Daniel Humana humbly puts it, "The books are all right here in plain view hidden from sight." Those able to find all of them will hear great lamentations from those who have to be shown. One revelation that may help is that books like Timothy and Samuel may occur without their numbers. Also, keep in mind, that punctuation and spaces in the middle are normal. A chipper attitude will help you compete really well against those who claim to know the answers. Remember, there is no need for a mad exodus; there really are 30 books of the Bible lurking somewhere in this paragraph waiting to be found. God Bless.

FAMILY CHALLENGE

(Choose 1 or 2 you might like to do as a family this week)

- Play Bible quiz games during family worship times. Here are some examples:
 - i) Bible charades/ Pictionary put words from a Bible story or passage on small pieces of paper (1 word per piece of paper). Ask family members to act (for charades) or draw pictures/ symbols on paper (for Pictionary) representing the word on the paper which the rest of the family will try to guess.

 - ii) **Bible Taboo** Read a passage or story in the Bible together.

Prepare beforehand a set of cards when you, as the parent, choose some words or names mentioned in that passage.

Write them on small cards with a list of 5 or more words under it, that they are not allowed to mention.

The rest of the family then tries to guess the word at the top of the card. The older children can be prepare the cards for the next passage or Bible story you use. The following link provides examples of the small cards and further explanation. https://youthministry.org.au/2009/03/15/bible-taboo/

iii) **Guess who?** This quiz game can be played after reading Bible stories from different parts of the Bible during the week.

Prepare 2 sets of the same small cards by writing the name of the person on top of the cards with a list of some information about them.

For example, their gender (male or female), Testament (old or new), book name (yes or no), Detail (prophet or Wiseman, or warrior, or royal etc) and character (goodie or baddie).

The person who will select a card for the rest of the family to guess does so from one pile of cards. The other set of cards is spread out on the floor or table for everyone to see.

Each person in the family looks at the cards and tries to guess it by asking questions that can be answered with a 'Yes' or 'No.' For example, "Are you male?" Or "Are you a goodie?" The family member that guesses it correctly with the least amount of questions, is the winner.

If you have a large family, you can divide them into 2 groups and limit questions to 10 per group to make people choose their questions carefully. The following link provides cards you can print out and explains the game further.

v) S.P.E.C.S.A.P - <u>S</u>ins, attitudes or actions to forsake; <u>P</u>romises - assurance or benefit for us to claim from God; <u>E</u>xamples - good attitudes to take from the verse; <u>C</u>ommands - directions from God; <u>S</u>tumbling blocks - things God warns us to avoid; <u>A</u>ctions - what we need to apply in our lives; <u>P</u>rayer - pray that God will help us to walk faithfully with God.

➤ Word/Theme study: Choose a specific word or theme your family is interested in and use a Bible Concordance to find other texts about that word or theme. Look up the Bible texts together and discuss what each text has to say about the word or theme you've chosen.

If you have easy access to the internet, then use a website like www.biblegateway.com by typing in the word or phrase in the search box, to locate other relevant Bible texts in many versions. Or you can you can type into google phrases like "Bible texts about..."

Explanation of the 'Rebus Verse' activity

(This is copied from "100 Creative ways 2 learn memory verses" by Karen Holford pg,56.)

Supplies

- Paper
- ➤ Pencils
- Pens and Markers
- ➤ A Variety of sticker sheets or printed clip art to suit the text being illustrated.

Instructions

 Create a Rebus by replacing some of the words in the verse with pictures. This activity is useful for early and pre-readers because the pictures help the children to guess some of the words. Choose verses containing several words for which you can find replacement pictures or stickers.

- Help the children to write out the verse to be learned, leaving spaces for small pictures where appropriate.
- Let the children place stickers or small pictures into the correct spaces in the verse.

Other ideas

- Help younger children by preprinting the verse with ready made spaces for the stickers and pictures, and give each of them a copy.
- Make a series of Rebus verses and let each child build up a small folder or booklet of Rebus verses that they can reread whenever they wish.
- ➤ Have older children draw their own pictures in the spaces.

During Family Worship you can discuss any of these questions: Choose the questions you think would work for your family - or create your own questions.

- Were you ever afraid of the dark when you were little? Why?
- Why do you think David calls God's word a lamp for his feet?
- 3) Why do you think some countries don't let Bibles come into their country?

- 4) What is your favourite story in the Bible? What makes this passage come alive for you?
- 5) What sort of things have you memorized without trying?
- 6) What stops you from being able to spend some time in the Bible each day? How can you readjust?
- 7) Have you ever written a letter to someone you love? How would you have felt if the person you loved just ignored your letter?

8) Do you have your own copy of the Bible? How often do you read it?

9) What ideas do you have for memorising verses from the Bible?




