HEY KIDS!

Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

- In this episode, Jono and Salome redeem some "lame" prizes with their tokens at the game alley. Sefa suggests they make a "bottle rocket" with the bottle and cork they won, and jots down some instructions on how to make it. Naturally, Jono gets distracted and decides to create a bottle rocket his own way, which leads to him making a hole in the wall. They try to paint over it, but accidentally use acid instead of paint, which makes the hole even bigger. Eventually the whole wall falls down! Luckily, Sefa agrees to fix all the mess.

Bible lesson

- Just like Jono decides not to follow his father's instructions, we often don't follow our heavenly Father's instructions. Even though God knows what's best for us, we try to do things our own way, and usually end up making things much worse than they need to be. Luckily, God is loving and gracious enough to fix our problems, if we ask Him.

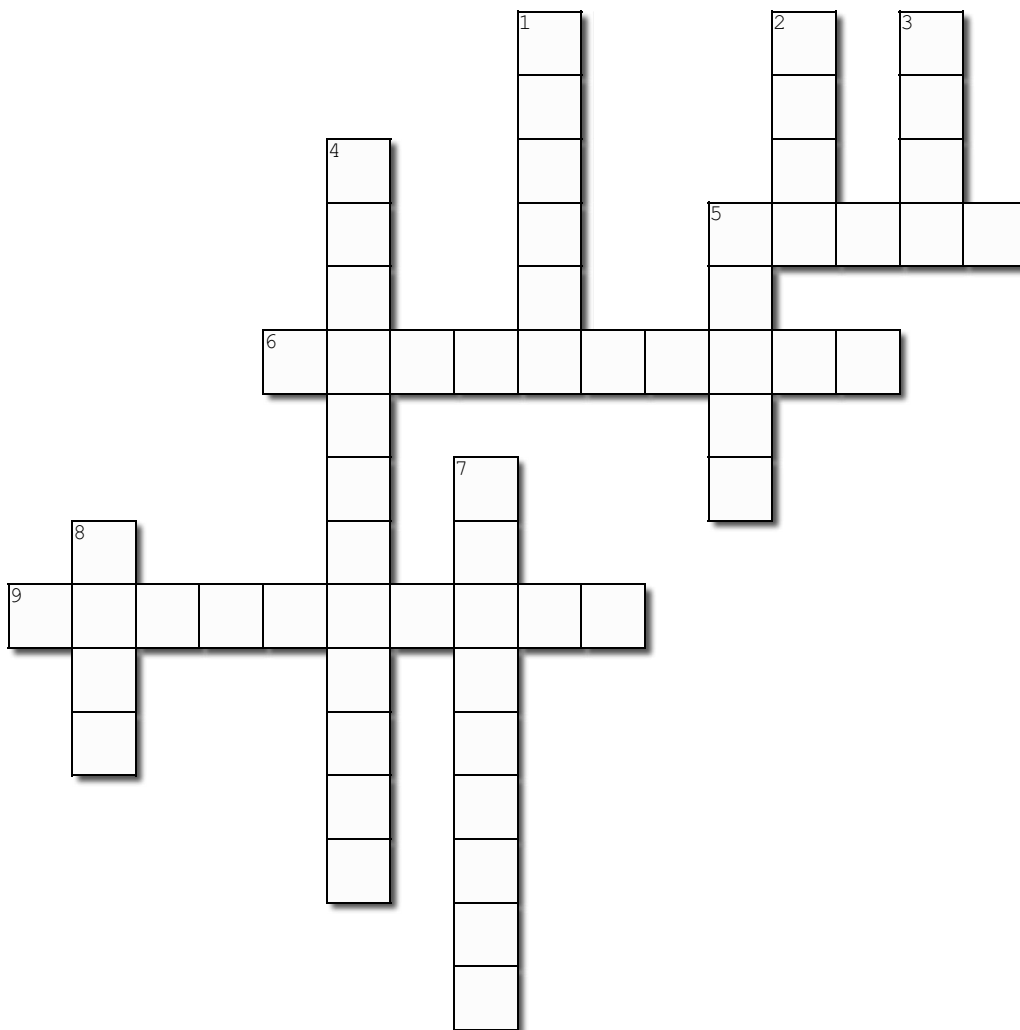
DID YOU KNOW?

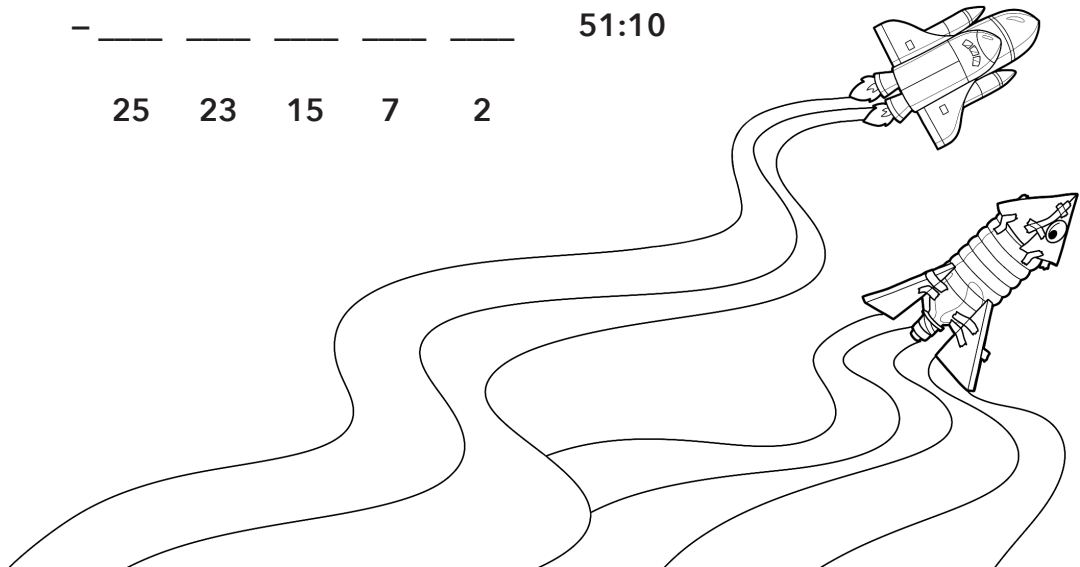

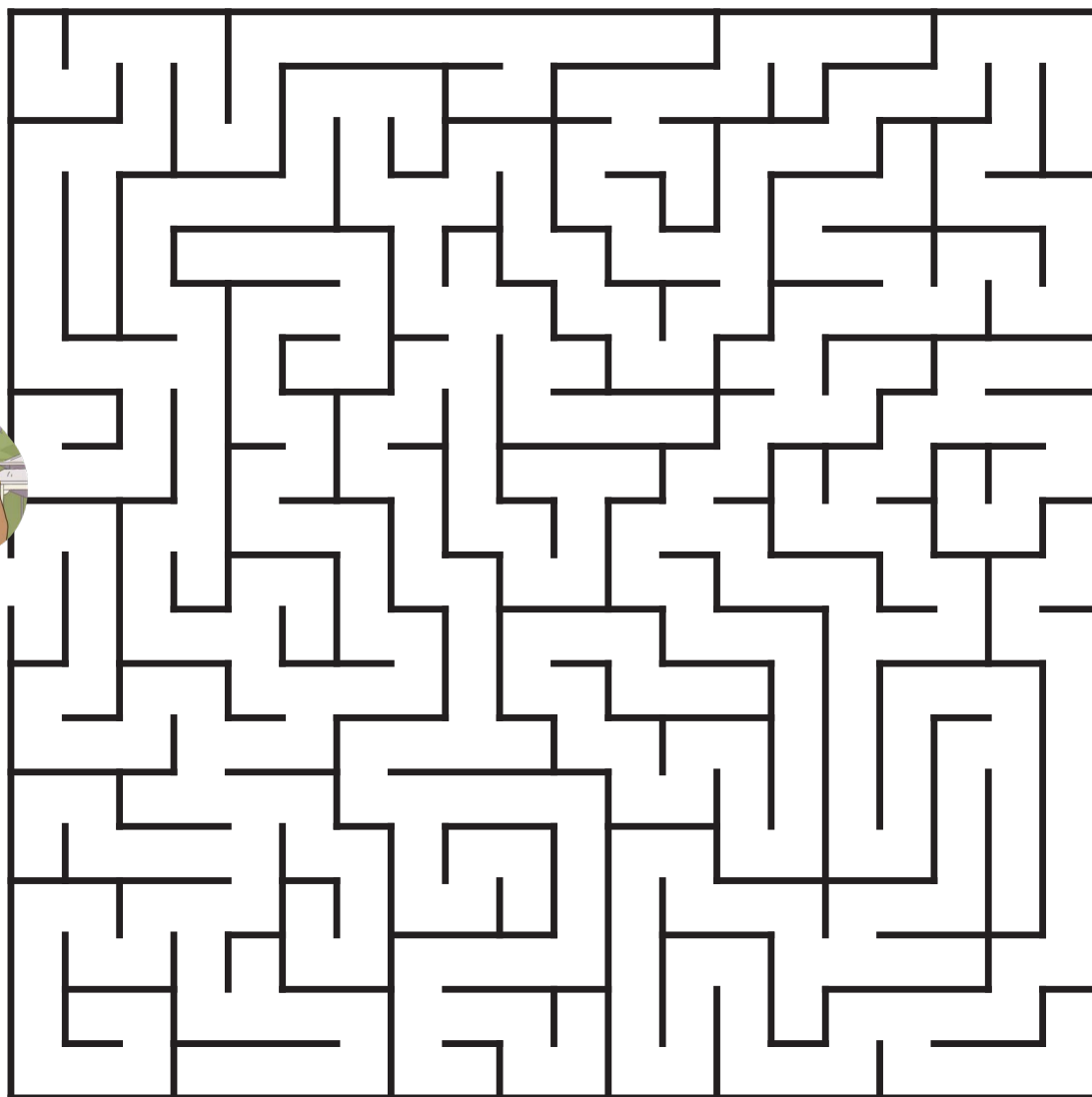

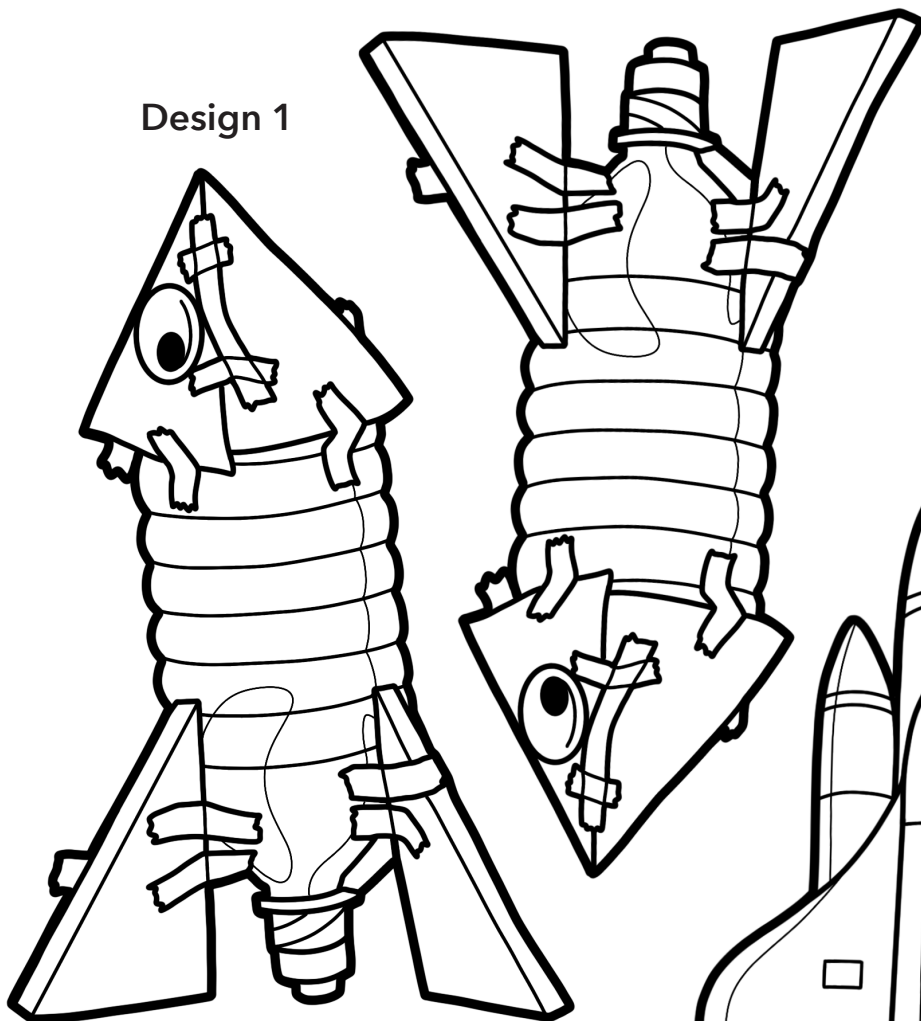

Make your own bottle rocket by following the instructions below!

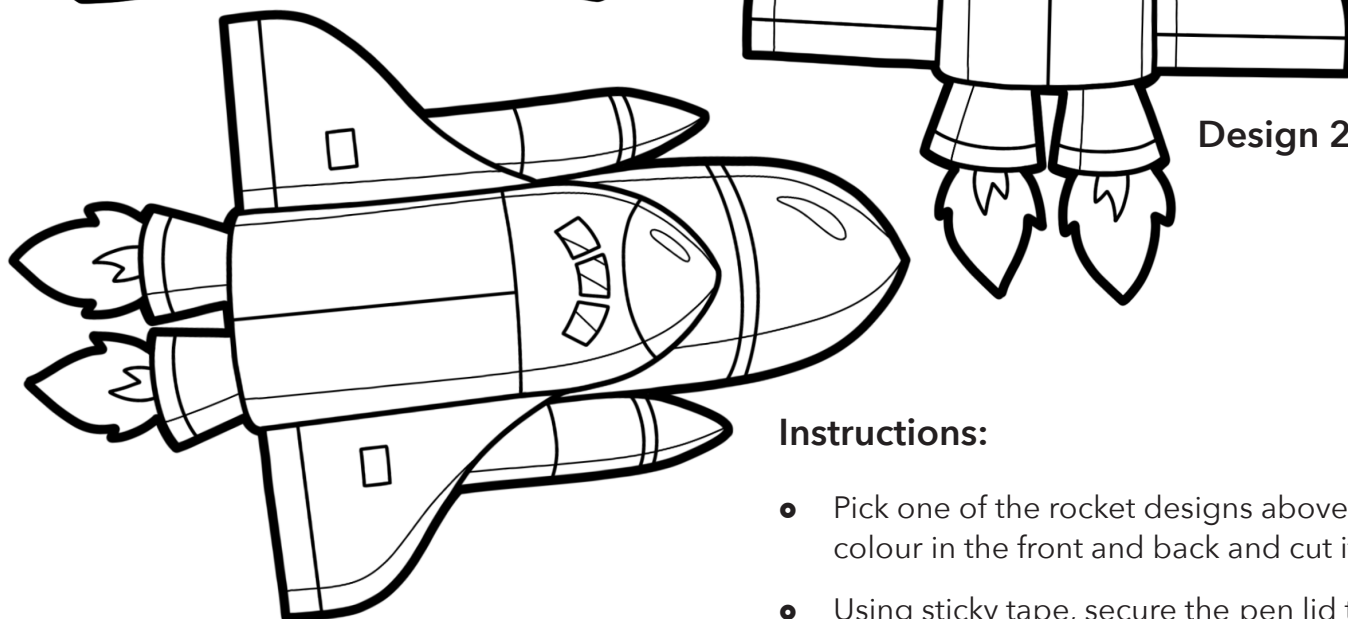
Design 1



What you'll need:

- Coloured pencils or textas
- Scissors and sticky tape
- Pen lid (must fit over the top of a straw)
- Straw

Design 2

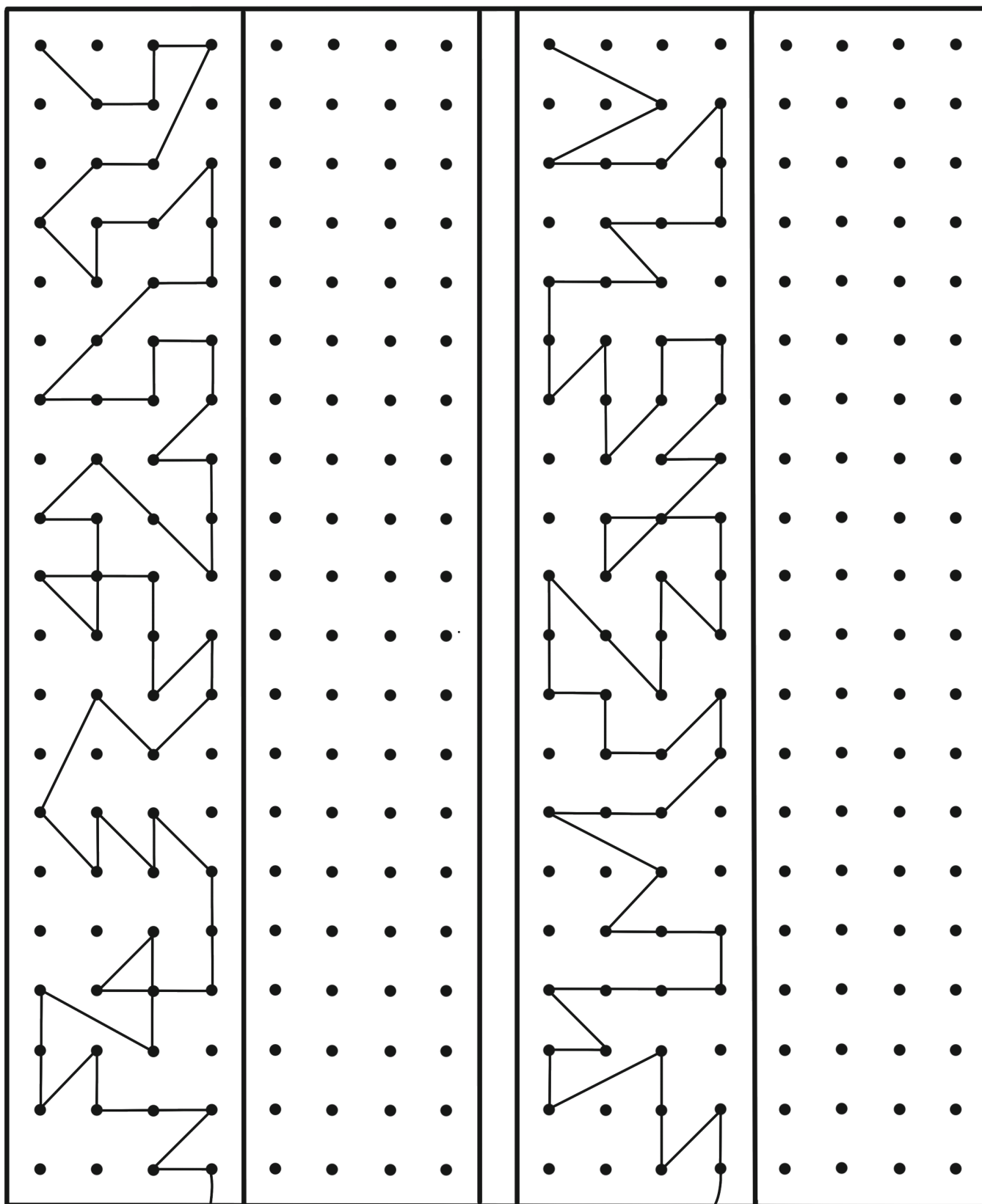


Instructions:

- Pick one of the rocket designs above, colour in the front and back and cut it out
- Using sticky tape, secure the pen lid to the back side of the rocket, then stick on the opposite side. The lid should sit between both halves.
- Slide the rocket over the top of a straw and blow upwards to watch it launch!

FAMILY WORSHIP IDEA

DIY Bottle Rocket

You can make a bottle rocket just like Jono and Salome - but this time, with a twist.

What you'll need:

- Permanent marker
- Pencils
- Vinegar & baking soda
- Plastic bottle & cork

Step 1: Get an empty plastic bottle and using the permanent marker, write on it one thing you want to surrender to God

Step 2: Tape pencils to the outside of the plastic bottle so the nose touches the ground when the bottle is upside down.

Step 3: Pour vinegar into the bottle, add the baking soda quickly and push in the cork.

Step 4: Flip the bottle rocket upside down and step back before it shoots away!
