HEY KIDS!

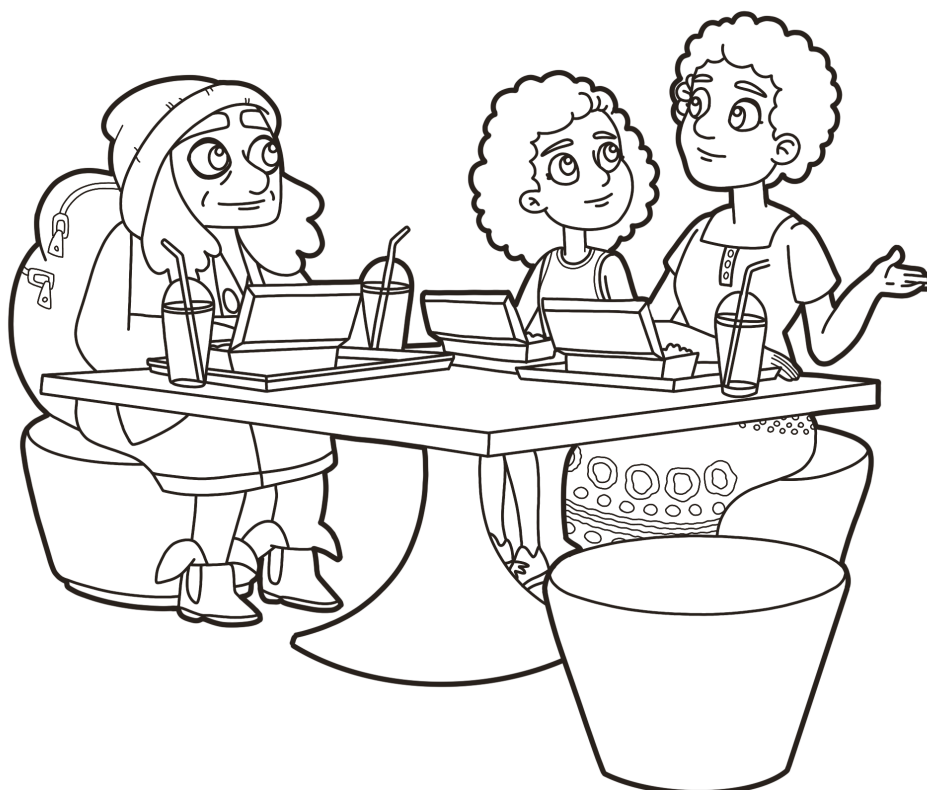
Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

- In this episode, Marica and Salome kindly ask Betty, a homeless woman, to have lunch with them. When Salome finds out that she has to search for food in the bin, she rallies the Pathfinders to raise money for the local soup kitchen. While most of them earn their money through honest work, Jono, Emma and Emily lie to innocent people to raise funds. When Marica finds out, they get into big trouble and have to pay everyone back. Despite this, the Pathfinders’ efforts mean that the homeless shelter can open one extra night per week.

Bible lesson

- While Salome wants to raise money honestly, Jono argues that he can raise money better by lying. He convinces Emma and Emily to do join him, and while they’re successful for a while, they all end up regretting it. This is like the war in Heaven between good and evil, where Satan convinces the world that his way is better, even though it’s not in the end.

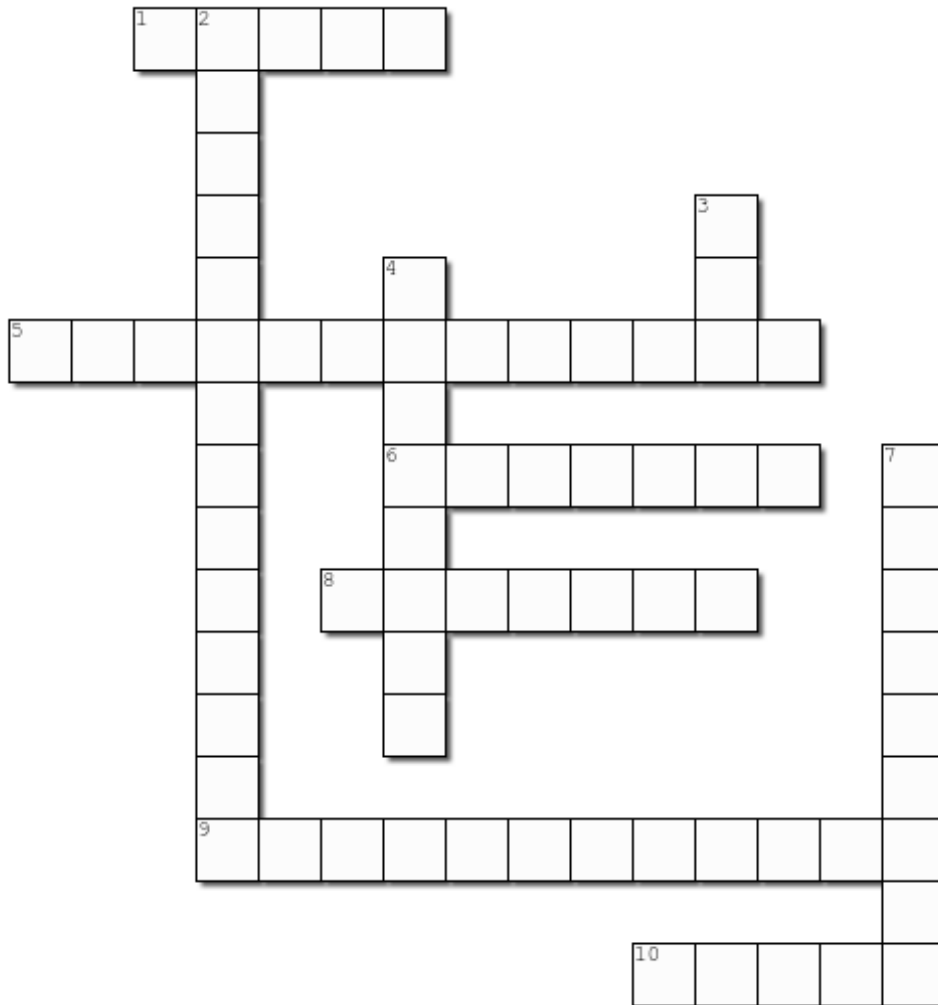

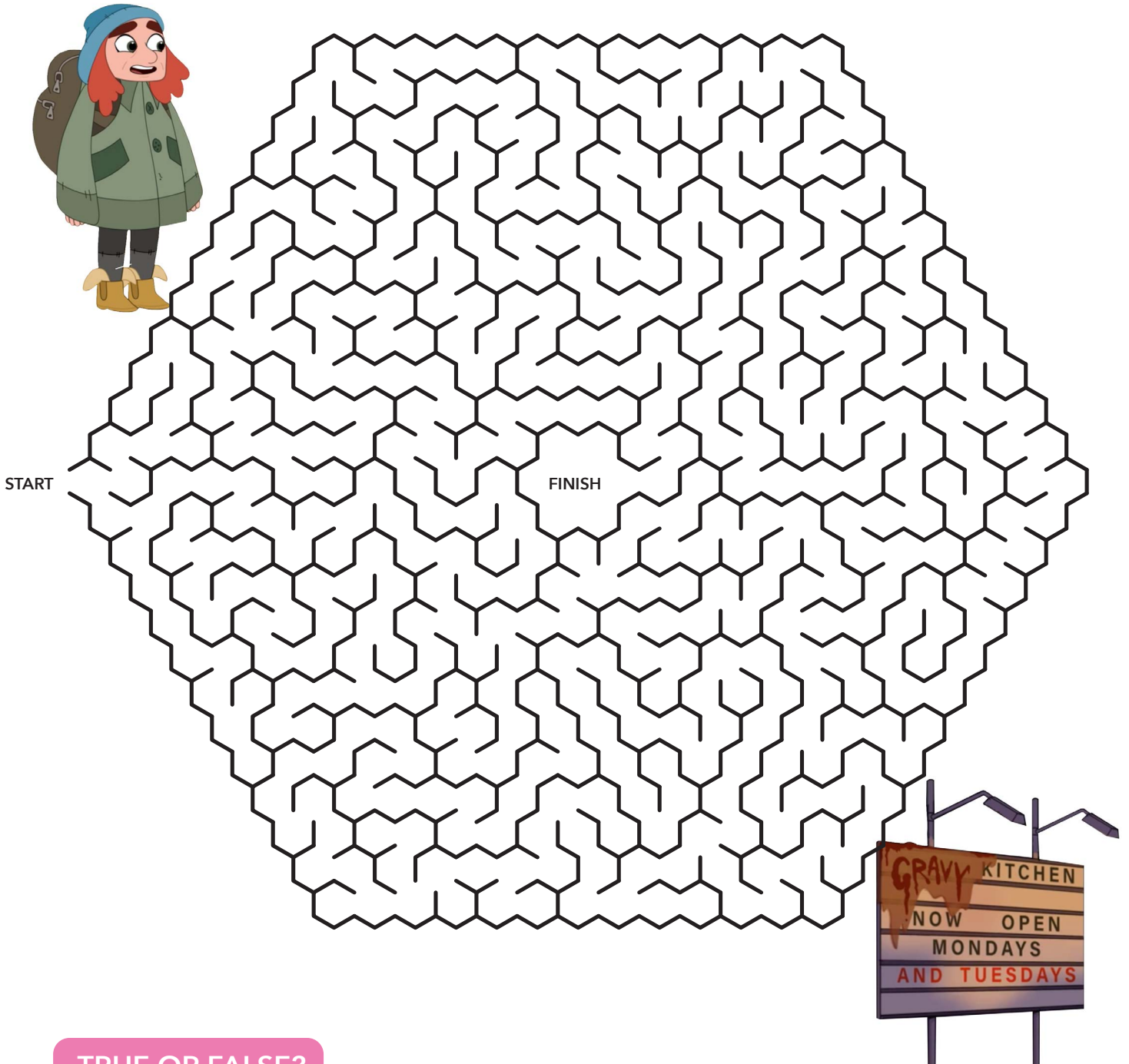

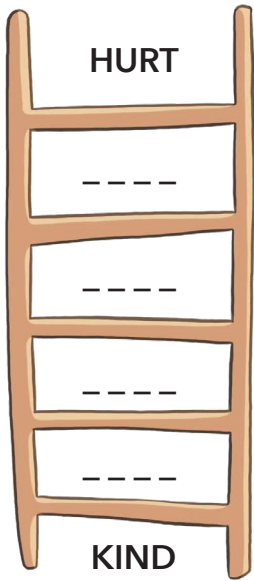
QUICK MATHS

Tin food drive
