HEY KIDS!

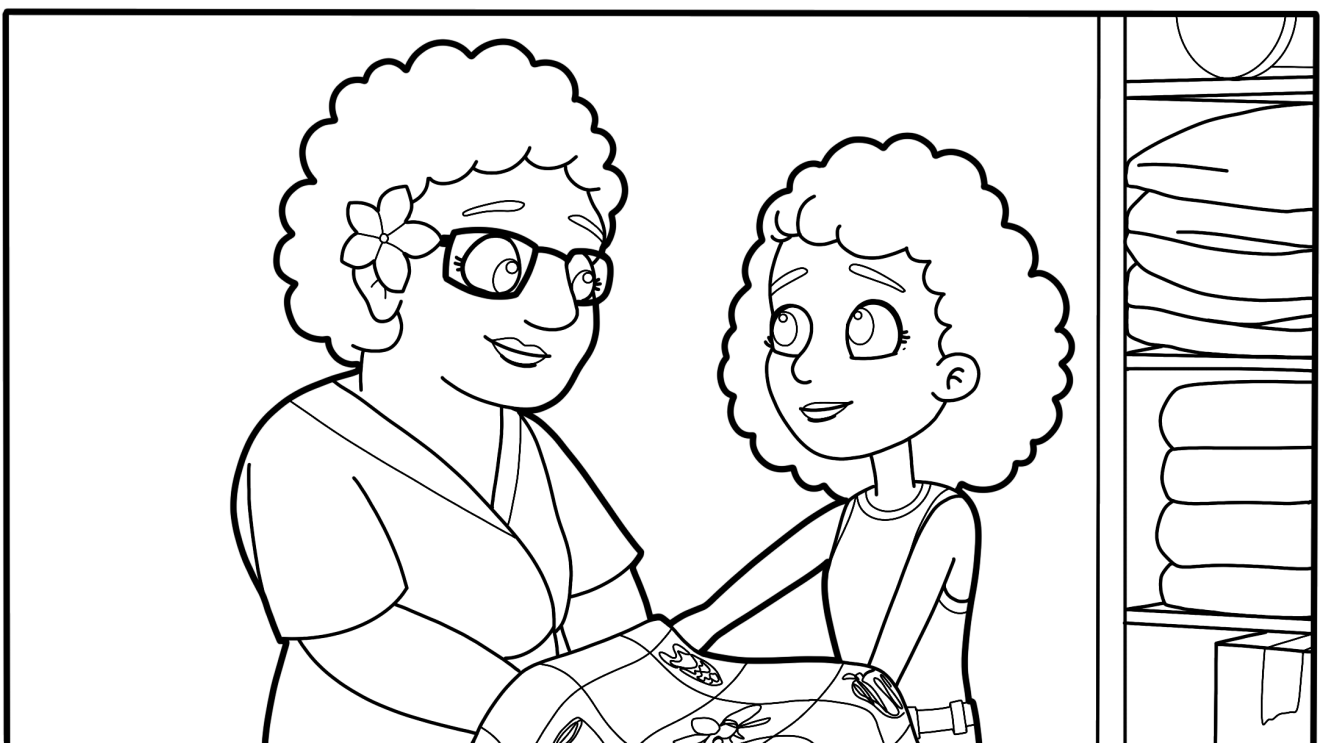
Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

- In this episode, the Tui family travels from Fiji to Brisbane for Remembrance Feast. Falling behind on preparations, Marica asks Salome and Jono to help decorate and set up, while she buys groceries. While she's out, Sefa's special cup goes missing. Jono and Salome put on their detective hats and look for clues to who might have stolen it. In the end, they find out that Tuks accidentally broke it and Sefa went to the garage to fix it. The family then enjoy their Remembrance Feast together.

Bible lesson

- Just like the Tuis gather for a feast, The Lord's Supper is a celebration that all Christians can participate in. It commemorates Jesus' death and resurrection and symbolises our faith in Him. By drinking the bread and wine, we are invited to examine ourselves (like detectives) and repent and confess our sins, believing that Jesus has forgiven them through His sacrifice.

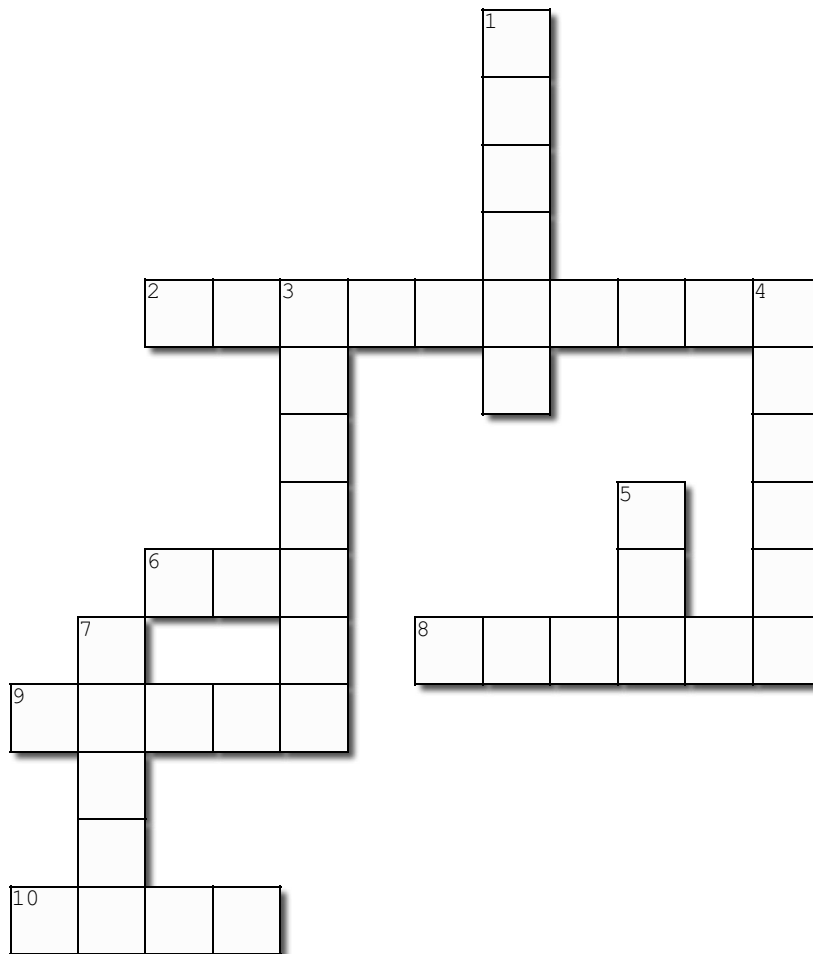
DID YOU KNOW?

MATCH THE SQUARES

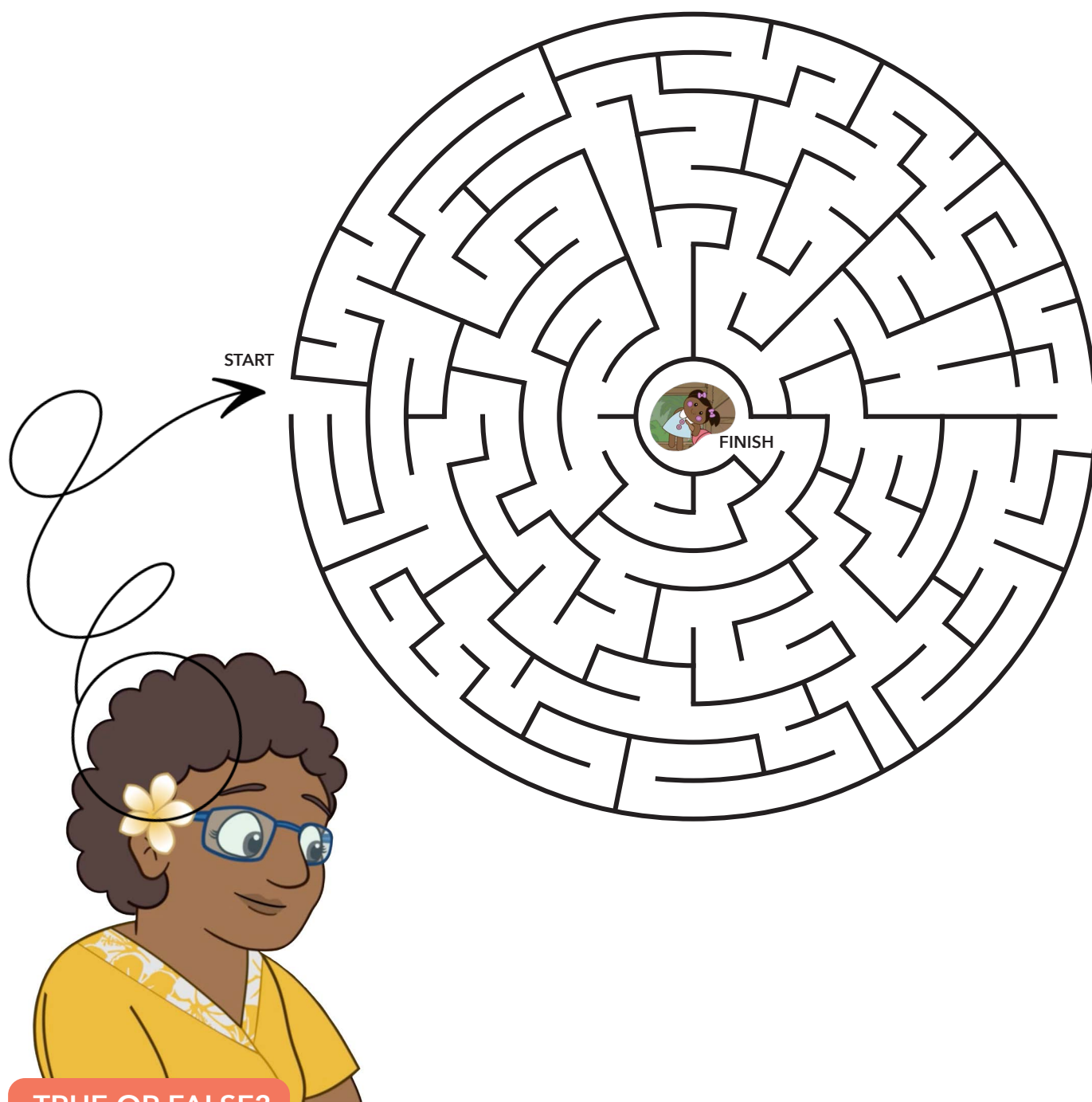
Cut out the nine squares below and put them into the grid to the right:

that the bread represented His broken body. When I eat "The Lord's Supper", at church, it helps me remember the sacrifice Jesus made for me on the cross.
