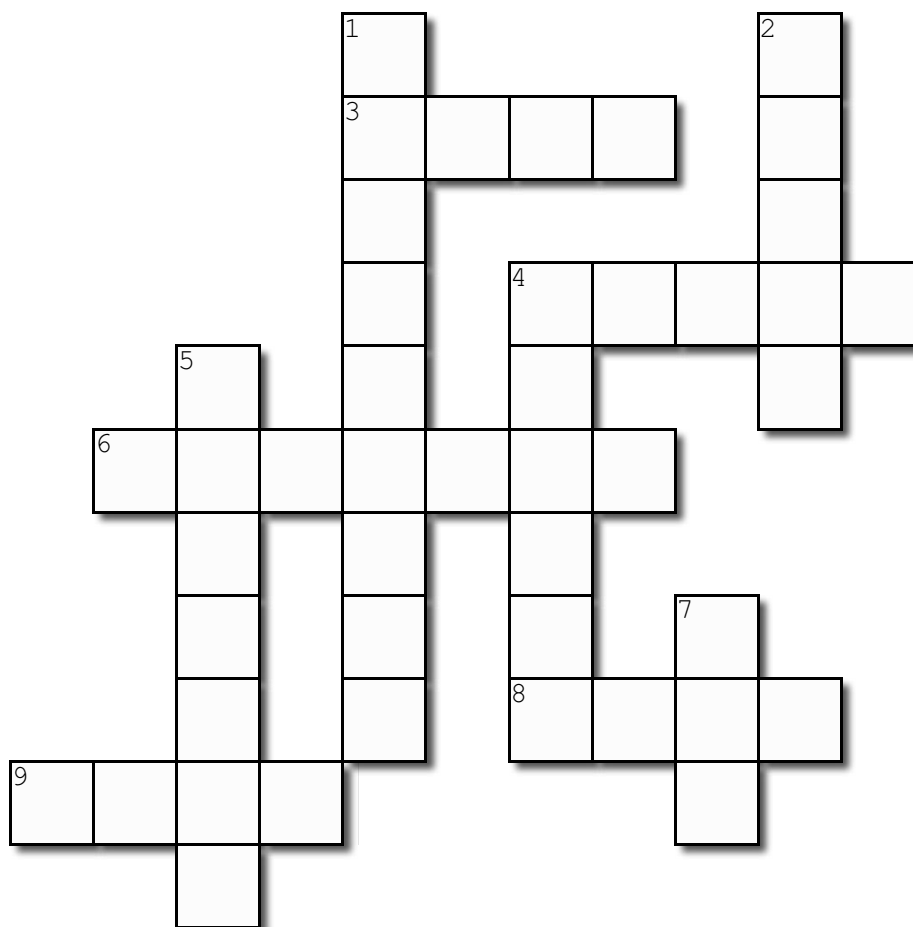
Bible lesson

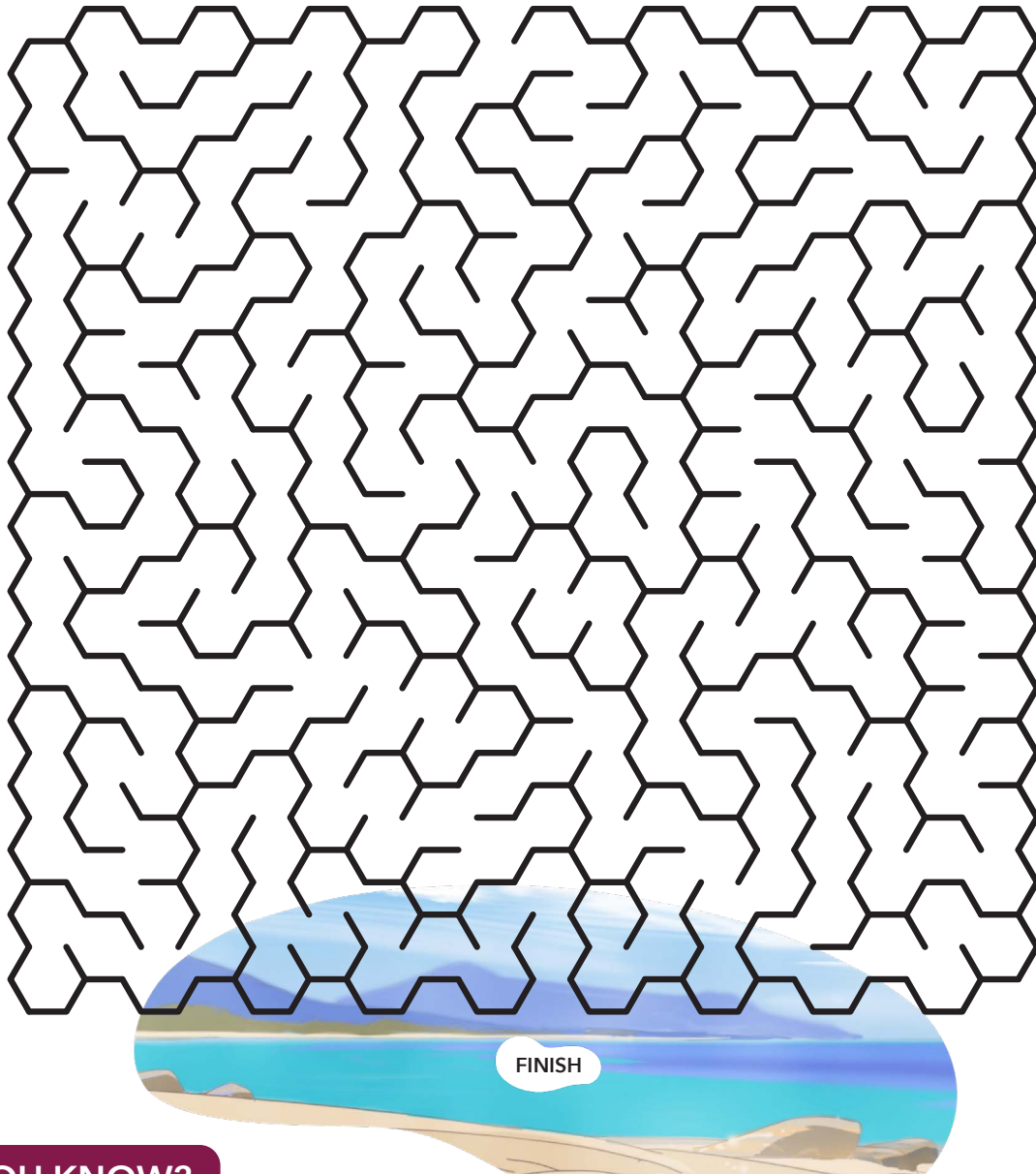


MAZE

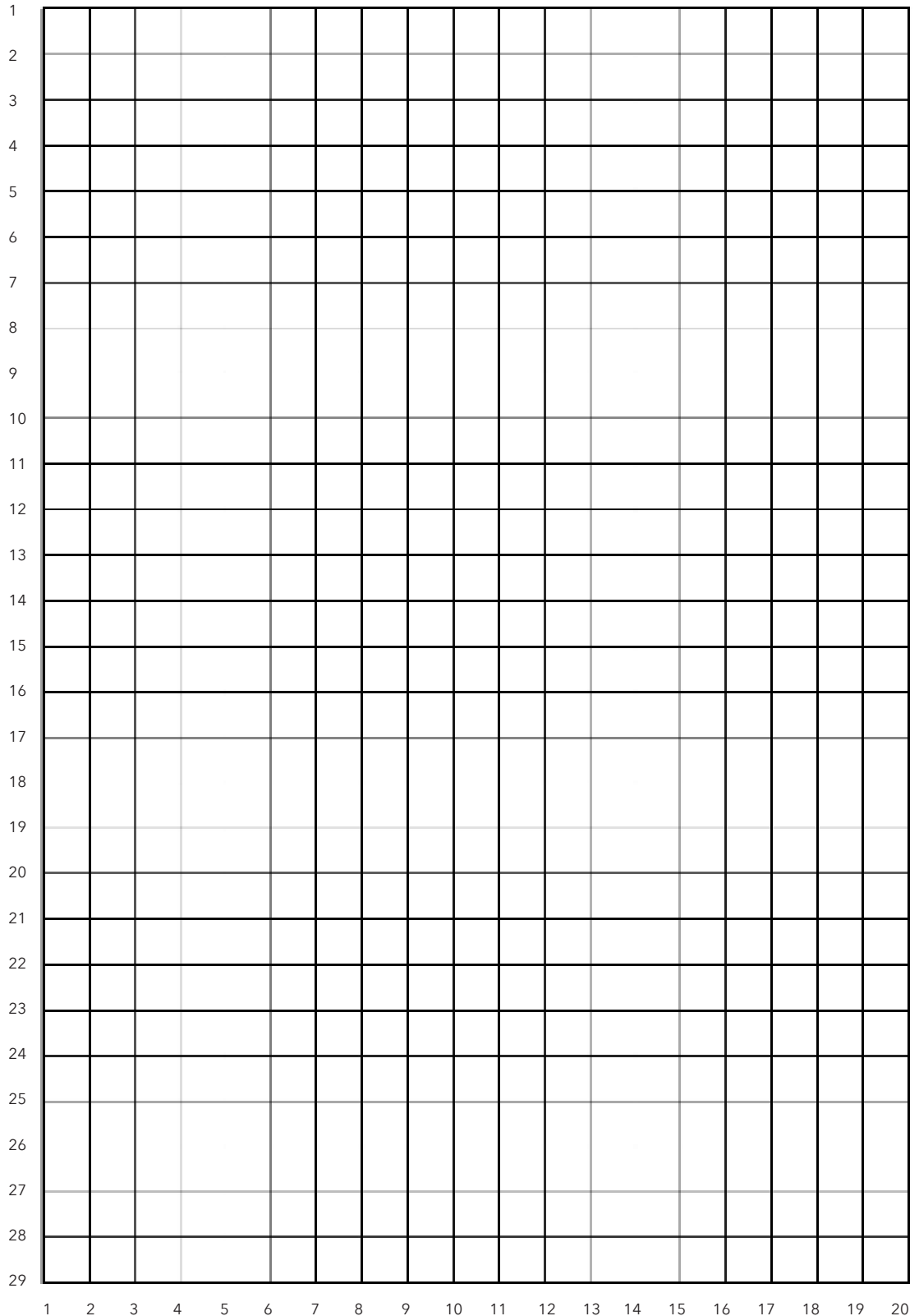

FAMILY WORSHIP ACTIVITY IDEAS

EPISODE QUESTIONS

- In this episode, Sefa tells the kids to build their sandcastles on rock because it's a strong foundation. What does this represent in the Bible, and how do we build our lives on it? (Read Matt 7:24-27).
- Peter gives the teams terrible advice that makes them lose. How can we make sure we listen to good advice only, like Sefa's, in our daily lives? How do we test what we hear?
- Would you like to be able to prophesy and predict the future? What advantages do you think it would bring, and what would be difficult about it? Share your thoughts with the group.

FAMILY WORSHIP IDEA

Junior Sandcastle Comp

Why not host your own junior sandcastle competition at your local beach?

What you'll need:

- Buckets, shovels and shovel
- Hat and sunscreen
- A beach OR sand & water
- A timer (optional)

Step 1: Split everyone into even teams and set the timer for 20 minutes. Tell the teams they must build what they imagine the "Kingdom of Heaven" will look like within the time limit.

Step 2: When the time is up, have each team describe the different features of their castle and what each represent.

Step 3: Read Revelation 21:1-5 together as a group. Ask each person what they are most looking forward to about Heaven.
