## HEY KIDS!

Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

## Episode summary

- In this episode, Costa gets a new skateboard for his birthday, so Marica takes everyone to the skatepark. While Salome takes Tuks to the under 3s area, Jono and Costa wait for Marica to get helmets and pads. While they wait, Tyson pressures them to ignore the skate park rules. As a result, Jono nearly lands on Tuks, but Costa pushes him out of the way just in time... only to break his leg and destroy his new board in the process. In hospital, Kaz visits Costa and invites him and Jono to join the skate school at the park where they can follow the rules properly.


## Bible lesson

- Just like there were rules at the skate park, God gives us rules in his Word-the Ten Commandments. Sometimes we might think they're optional or there to stop us from having fun, but they're actually there to keep us safe. Although we can never keep them perfectly, trying to obey God's commandments demonstrates our love for Him and others.

## FAMILY WORSHIP IDEA

## Ten Commandments Scroll

Let's make our own version of the Ten Commandments!

## What you'll need:

- A4 paper, or butchers paper
- $2 x$ rolling pins or long toilet paper rolls
- Sticky tape, glue, pens and pencils

Step 1: Take a long sheet of butchers paper, or glue two A4 sheets together at the top

Step 2: Read Exodus 20 or Deuteronomy 5 and write out the 10 Commandments in your own words

Step 3: Once satisfied, tape the top of your paper to the rolling pin or toilet paper roll. Tape the other to the bottom of the paper, and then roll them together.

Step 4: Unfurl your scroll and read it aloud!
