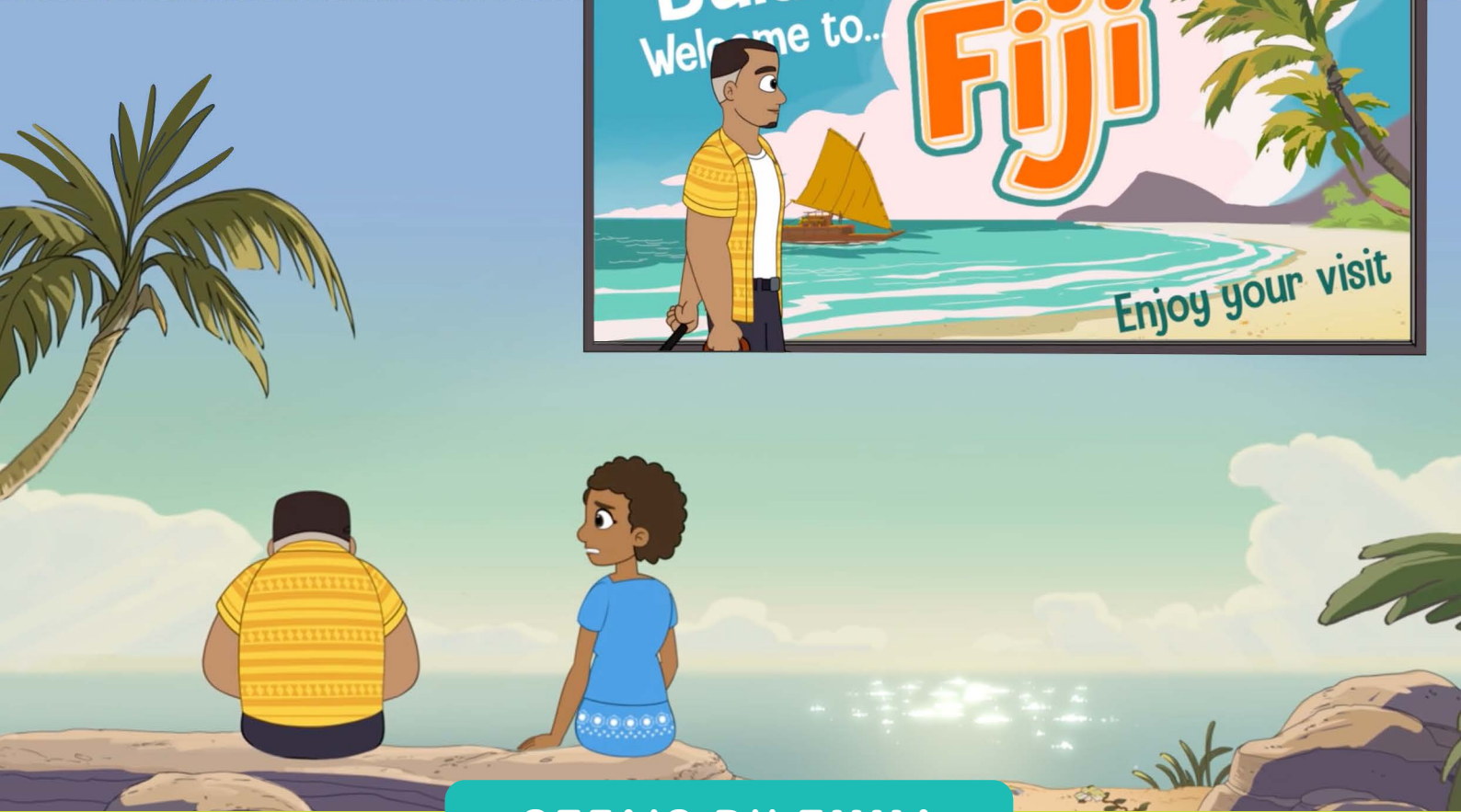

HEY KIDS!

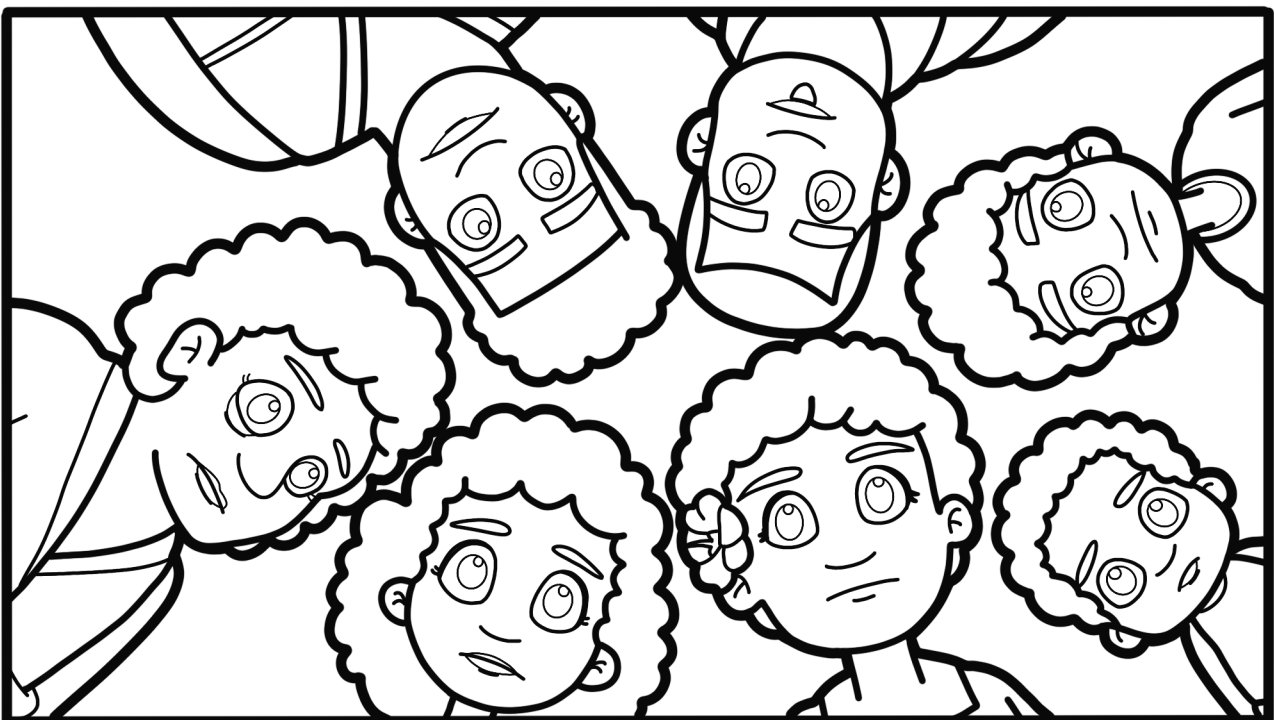
Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

- In this episode, Salome, Jono and Tuks find out that Sefa faints at the sight of needles. When they receive a package in the mail to tell them that their grandma—Nanda—is sick, the whole family flies to Fiji. When they arrive, they discover that Nanda has a rare blood disease that can only be cured if Sefa donates his blood. Being so afraid of needles, Sefa is troubled but ultimately decides to make the sacrifice and take the procedure. Jono also sacrifices his birthday money to buy Nanda blue nailpolish and paints Sefa’s nails, too.

Bible lesson

- Just like Sefa and Jono made sacrifices in this episode, Jesus also sacrificed Himself for you. He didn’t just overcome his fear or selfishness to do a good deed, though. He died for you, so that you could live free from sin and have the opportunity to experience eternal life in Heaven.

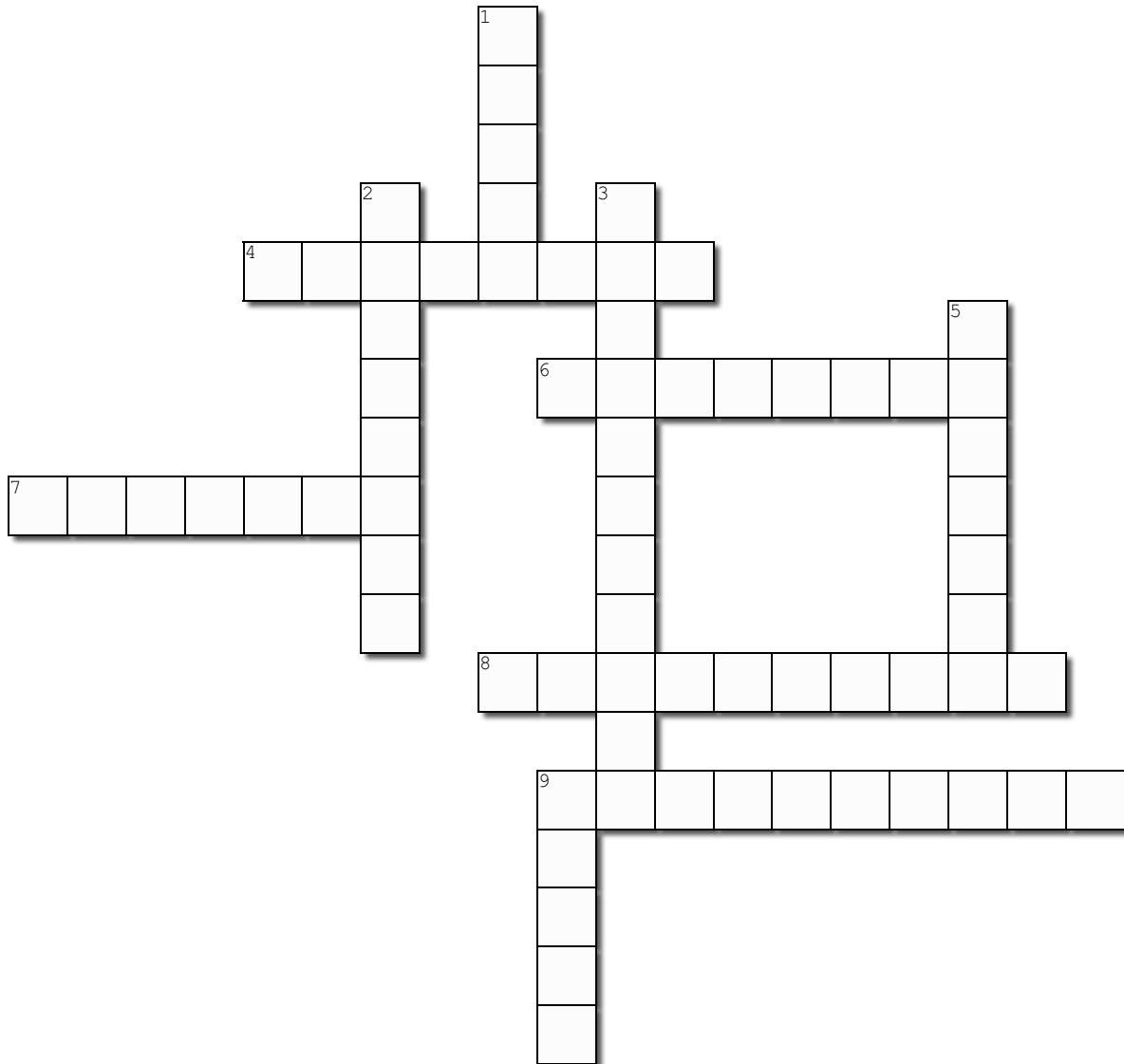
DID YOU KNOW?

RARE

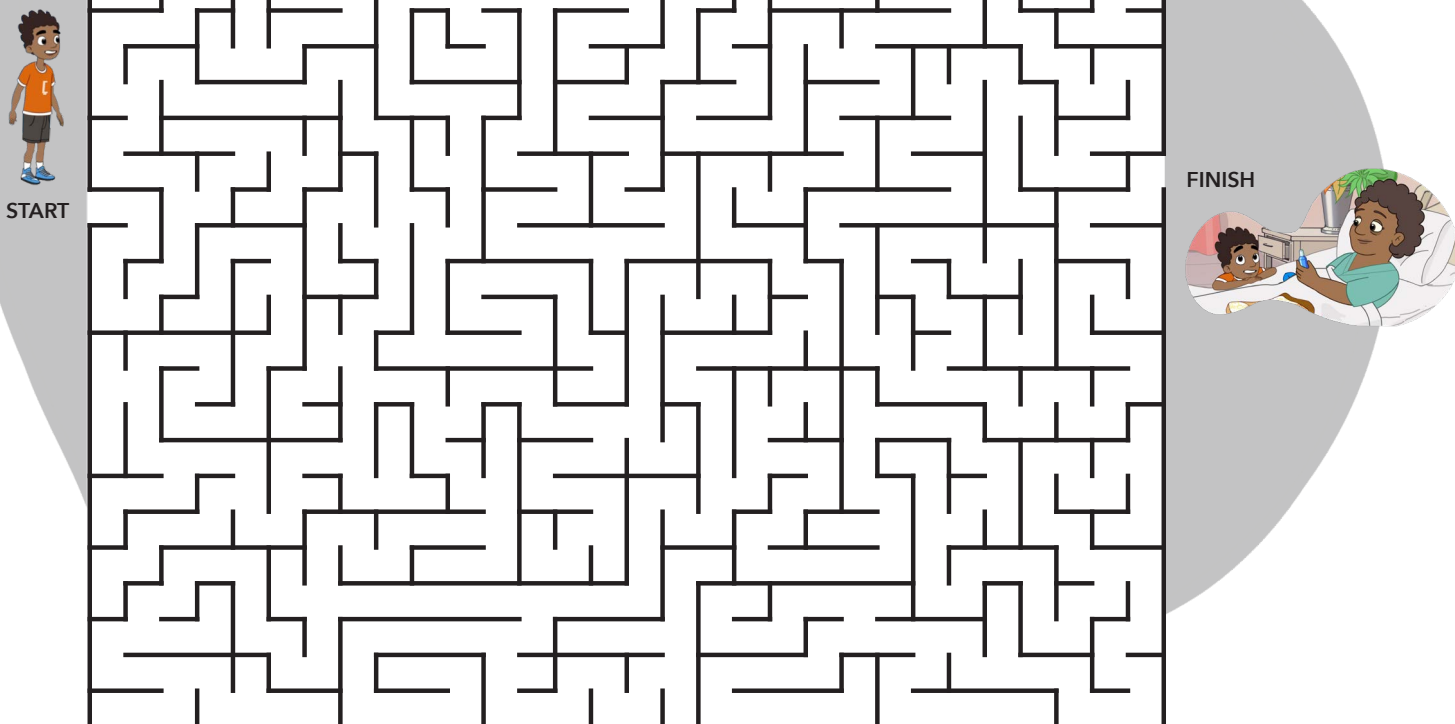
WASH

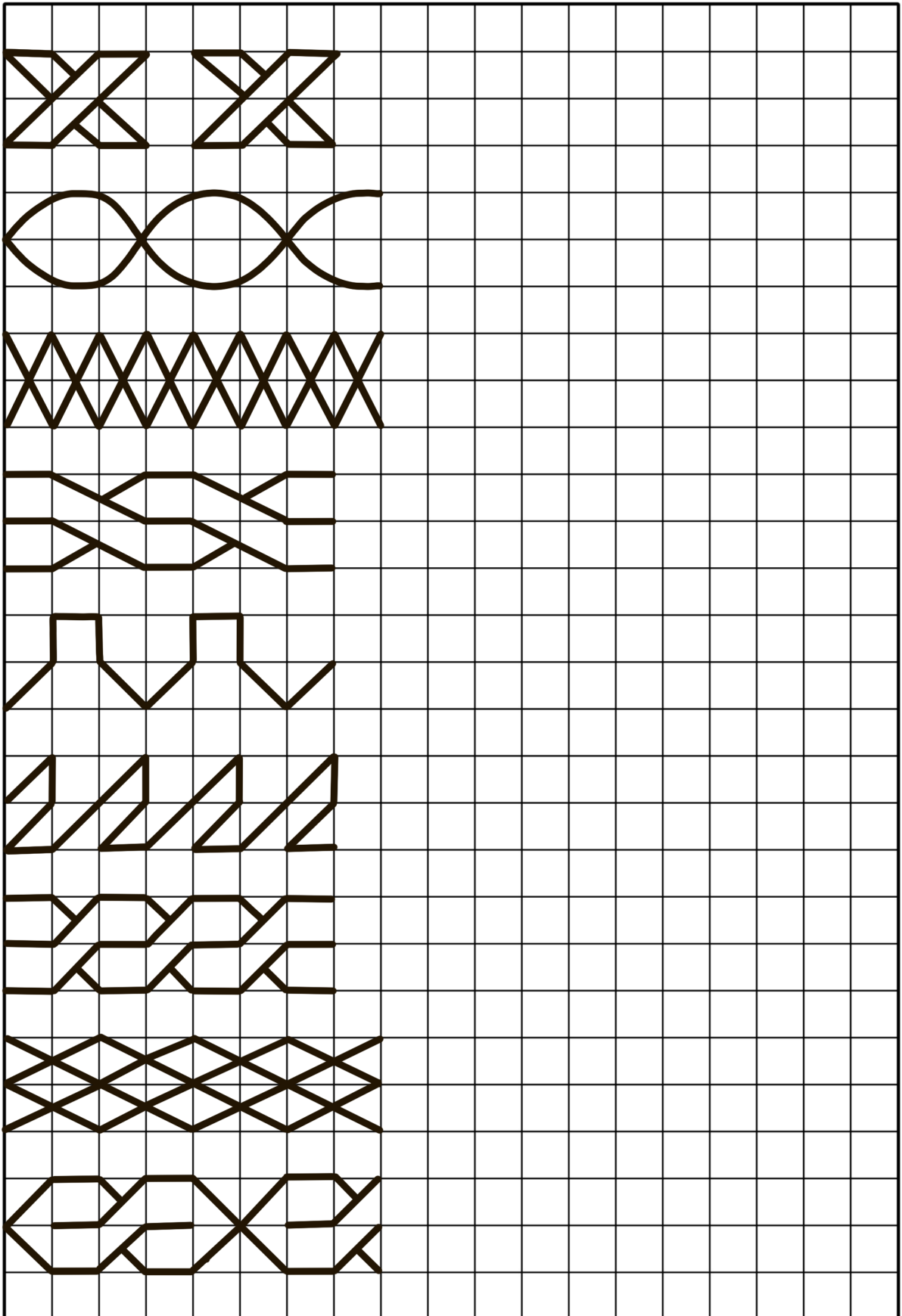
SPOT THE DIFFERENCE

What you'll need:

- Paper, pens and pencils
- Gifts (food, flowers—your choice)

Step 1: Think of someone you know who is sick, in hospital or in a nursing home.

Step 2: Write them a letter telling them that you're thinking of them or praying for them.

Step 3: Buy or make a gift. You could collect flowers, make a craft, buy some treats, or even visit them in person and sing some songs (if restrictions allow).

Step 4: Repeat the process in a few weeks time, if you can.
