HEY KIDS!

Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

• In this episode, the Tuis go and visit Marica's dad, Pa. When they arrive, the kids get bored so Pa suggests they go to the beach and try some "Bu", or coconut water. Sefa's brothers try to collect the coconuts, but fail to dislodge them from the tall palm trees. Pa then tells them about the legend of "The Great Sautu"–a strong man who would effortlessly climb the palms to bring coconuts to all who asked. The family is surprised to find that the Great Sautu is actually Sefa, who brings everyone coconuts to enjoy.

Bible lesson

• Just like Sefa, "The Great Sautu", loves bringing delicious coconuts to his family, God loves giving good gifts to His children (Matthew 7:11). Like Sefa's brothers, sometimes we try to acquire these good things all by ourselves, forgetting that we need God's help. God is loving, generous and strong, and will always answer our prayers (1 John 5:15).


DID YOU KNOW?




