HEY KIDS!

Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

- In this episode, the Tuis go to the "Puddle Puggles" concert, which inspires Salome and Jono to put on a live show! Jono does sock puppets, Salome dances, and Costa helps by playing a one-stringed guitar. Unfortunately, the show flops and the audience leaves. Then, Jason from the Puddle Puggles gifts them a puppet, dancing shoes, a 12-stringed guitar, and a microphone. They decide to put on the show again, and Emma and Emily join in singing. This time, with the right tools, the show goes off without a hitch!

Bible lesson

- Just like Jason gives Salome, Jono and Costa the tools they need to put on a proper show, God gives each of us special gifts that we can use to build His kingdom. These include faith, healing, prophecy, proclamation, teaching, administration, reconciliation, compassion and service... and more!

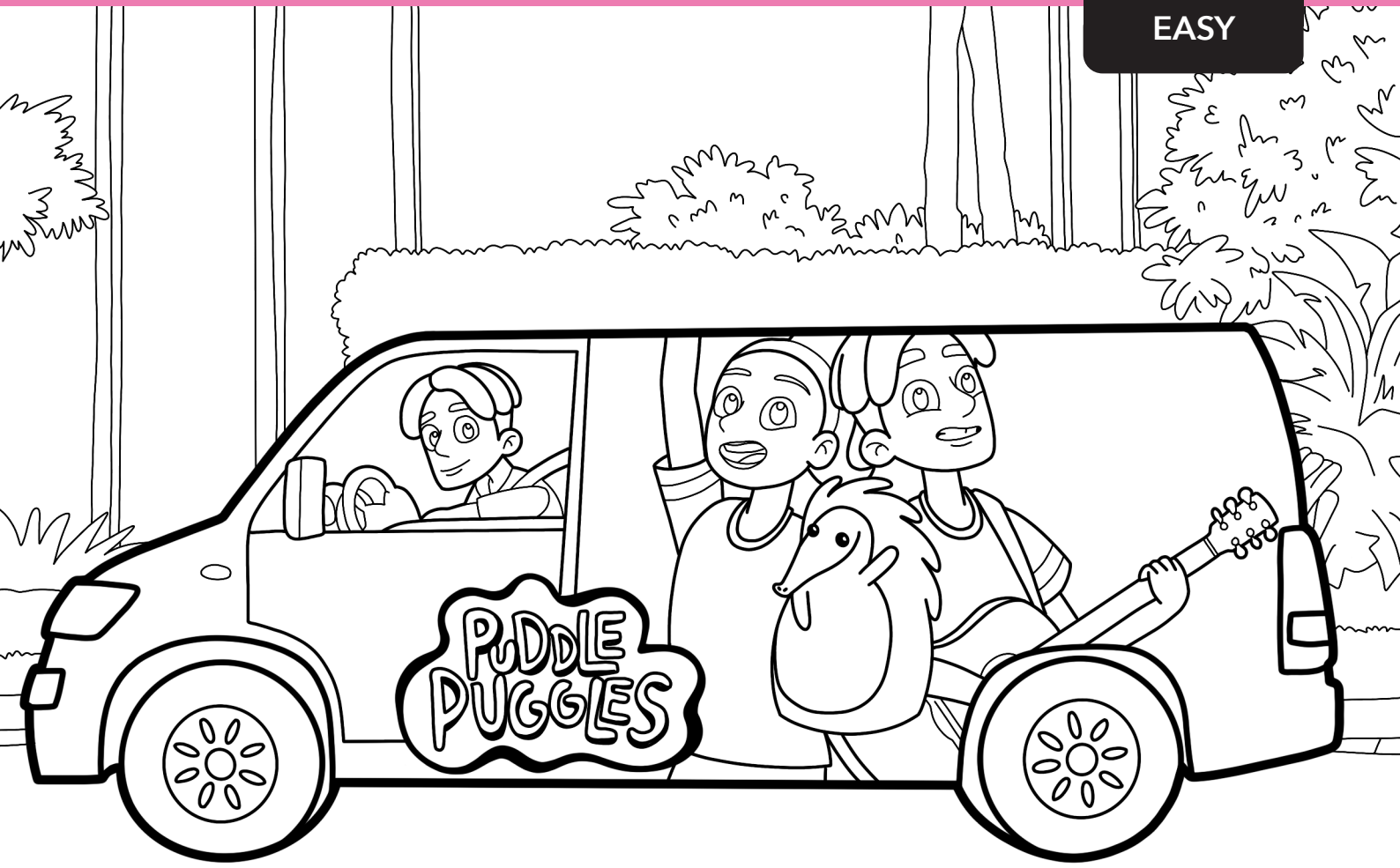

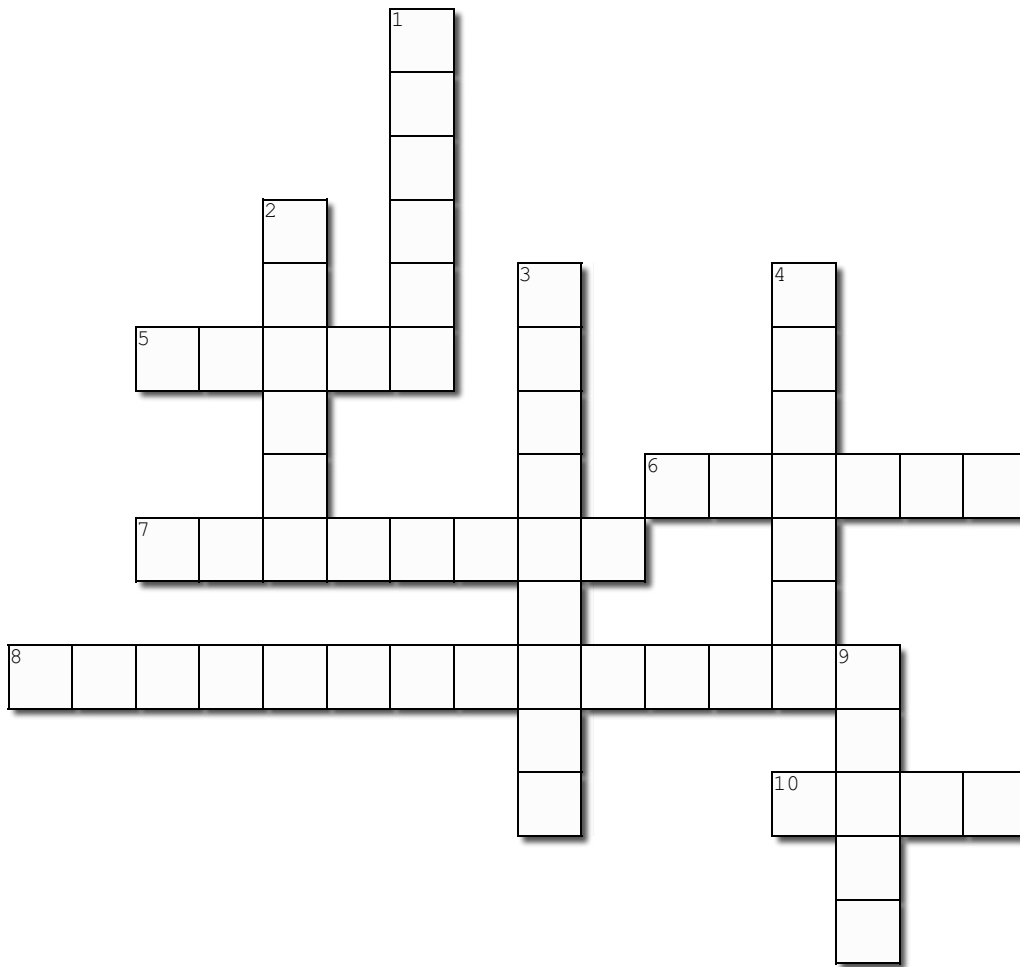
DID YOU KNOW?

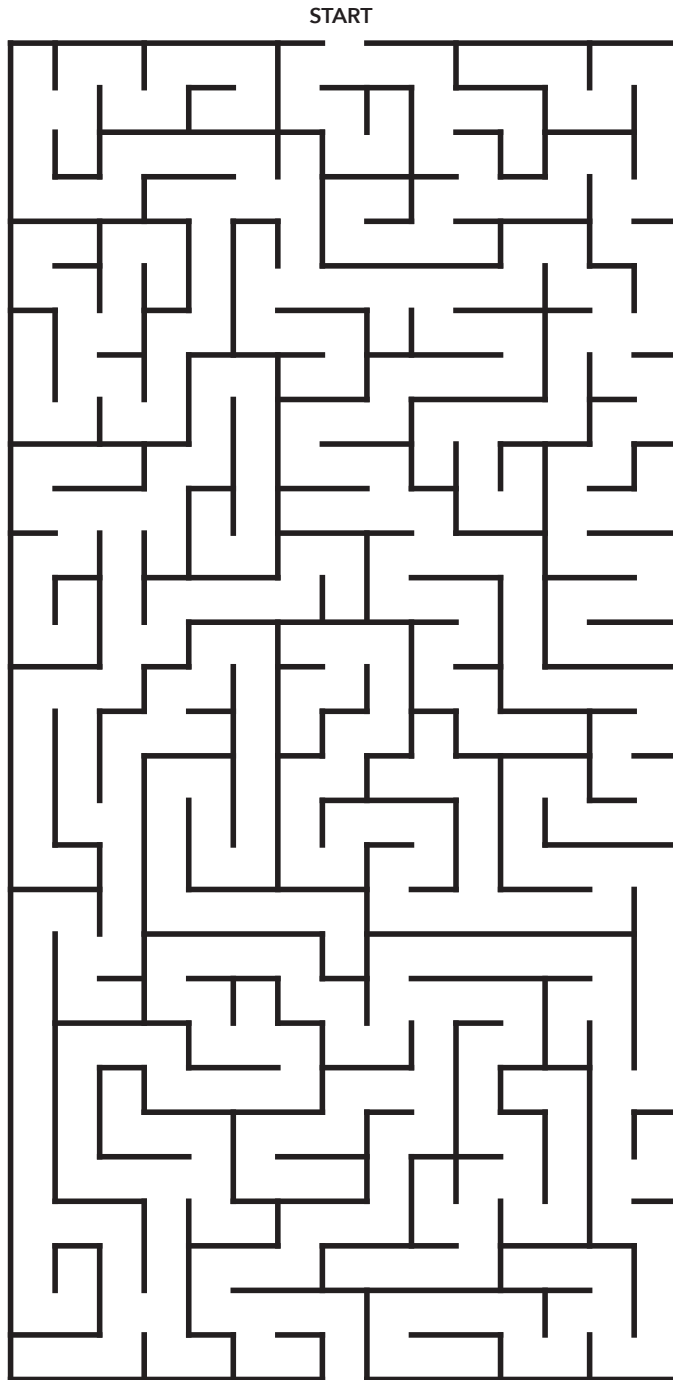
FINGER PUPPETS

EPISODE QUESTIONS

- In this episode, we see that the characters have lots of different talents—singing, playing an instrument, dancing, acting... What talents has God given you? How can you use them to serve?
- What "tools" do you use to demonstrate your talents (e.g. paintbrushes, piano lessons etc). Who gave them to you? How can you show your gratitude to that person?
- Think of a creative way that you could help out a friend or serve your community. What talents would you need to achieve that idea? Who can you think of who have those talents?

FAMILY WORSHIP IDEA

Act it out!

It's time to put on a show, using inspiration from Bible stories!

What you'll need:

- A group of 4+ people
- 4+ pre-chosen Bible stories

Step 1: Divide everyone into two groups.

Step 2: Give each group a Bible story, and

give them a few minutes to plan how they're going to act it out in front of the other group. The only catch? They can't talk!

Step 3: Give group 2 three chances to guess what story group 1 is acting out. If group 2 guesses correctly, group 1 gets a point.

Step 4: Go back and forth, giving the teams new Bible verses each round. The winning team is the one with the most points.
