HEY KIDS!

Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

• In this episode, the Tuis spend their final days in Fiji exploring the island. While Nanda, Marica, Salome and Tuks decide to go to the markets, the boys try their hand at fire dancing. The girls take a wrong turn and end up in the jungle with a flat tyre, with Tuks locked in the car! Marica calls Pa for help, and Pa sends Sefa with his car full of tools. Sefa pulls the car out of the ditch, while Jono pulls a "slippery salamander" to rescue Tuks from the car. Everyone is returned safely for an evening of fire dancing, where Pa, Sefa and Jono put on an amazing show!

Bible lesson

• Just like Pa sends Sefa with his van full of tools to save the girls, God sent his Son Jesus to earth to save us from sin. And just like Jono slips through a crack in the sun roof, the Holy Spirit can enter any place when we call on Him–even our hearts! Although we can't fully understand it, God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit work as a 3-in-1 team to save all people.


DID YOU KNOW?

- It is believed that fire dancing originated in Polynesia. While many people think the Maori people of New Zealand were the pioneers, it is not known for sure.
- Fire dancers protect theselves by wearing natural, non-synthetic fibres like cotton, wool, silk or suede, that won't melt against their skin and burn them.


